NON-CME WORKSHOPS

Two rooms, next to the exhibit hall and the plenary room, will be available for industry workshops during the following times:

- Thursday, March 30 immediately following course sessions and just before the Welcome Reception (tentatively 17:00-18:00)
- Friday, March 31 during the lunch break (tentatively 12:10-13:10)

Workshop rooms will accommodate 35-40 people in theater seating, with basic AV (microphone, screen, LCD projector) provided. One company per room, with workshops available on a first-come, first-serve basis. **Due to the limited number of workshop times, companies may request a maximum of two workshops, one as first choice and one as second in the first offering. Only the first choice for each company will initially be approved, based on dates requests are received. If, after February 3, any workshop times remain, second choices may be approved, based on dates initial applications were received.** Presentations should be on relevant, spine deformity topics, presented by industry-appointed instructors. SRS course faculty are eligible to participate as instructors (with the exception of the SRS President, President Elect, Vice President and Past President I) but sponsoring companies may NOT provide compensation or reimbursement of any kind to members of the SRS course faculty.
