

WHEREAS, scoliosis, an abnormal curvature of the spine, with no known cause, is a condition affecting two to three percent of the population, or an estimated seven million people in the United States; and

WHEREAS, scoliosis is a condition which strikes without regard to gender, race, age, or economic status; and

WHEREAS, an estimated one million scoliosis patients utilize health care yearly; and

WHEREAS, approximately one of every six children diagnosed with this condition eventually requires active medical treatment; and

WHEREAS, the primary age of onset for scoliosis is between 10 and 15 and females are five times more likely to progress to a curve magnitude that requires treatment; and

WHEREAS, screening programs allow for early detection and for treatment opportunities which may alleviate the worst effects of the condition;
