adults, and health care providers understand, recognize and treat the complexities of spinal

WHEREAS, an estimated one million scoliosis patients utilize health care yearly, with approximately one of every six children diagnosed with this condition eventually being required to receive active medical treatment; and, WHEREAS, the primary age of onset for scoliosis is between ten and fifteen, with females

being five times more likely to progress to a curve magnitude that requires treatment, and,

WHEREAS, screening programs allow for early detection, and for treatment opportunities which may alleviate the worst effects of the condition:
