## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Scoliosis, an abnormal curvature of the spine, with no known cause, is a condition

affecting 2-3% of the population, or an estimated 7 million people in the United States. Scoliosis is a condition which strikes without regard to gender, race, age or economic

status; and

WHEREAS: Public awareness of scoliosis will help children, parents, adults, and health care

providers understand, recognize, and treat the complexities of spinal deformities such as

scoliosis; and

WHEREAS: An estimated one million scoliosis patients utilize health care yearly, with approximately

one of every six children being diagnosed with this condition eventually being required

to receive active medical treatment; and

WHEREAS: The primary age of onset for scoliosis is between ten and fifteen, with female patients

being five times more likely to progress to a curve magnitude that requires treatment;

and

WHEREAS: Screening programs allow for early detection, and for treatment opportunities which

may alleviate the worst effects of the condition.
