- WHEREAS, scoliosis, the abnormal curvature of the spine, is a musculoskeletal disorder that affects an estimated seven million people in the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the onset of scoliosis occurs primarily between the ages of ten and fifteen with females being five times more likely to progress to a curve magnitude that requires treatment; and
- WHEREAS, an estimated one million scoliosis patients utilize health care yearly, with approximately one of every six children diagnosed with this condition eventually being required to receive active medical treatment; and
- WHEREAS, while scoliosis has no known cause, screening programs allow for early detection and for treatment opportunities which may alleviate the worst effects of the condition; and
- WHEREAS, raising public awareness of scoliosis is vital in helping children, parents, and healthcare providers understand, diagnose, and treat this condition and reduce the risk of debilitating complications.
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Henry McMaster, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim June 2021 as
